1. CONDITIONS FOR ADMITTANCE.

Your child may be registered if he is 3 years old within the 31 December of the current year or the 31 January of the following one. It's required the payment of a monthly fee including the child's insurance and taken meals.

2. SCHOOL HOURS

After a period in which the school hours are reduced to permit the child's insertion, the attendance will be in the morning and in the afternoon, from Monday to Friday, usually from (7.00) 8.00 to 4 o'clock p.m. (5 o'clock p.m.), up to the 30 of June.
School is closed on Saturday.

3. SCHOOL CANTEEN

Taken meals must be paid. The menu changes and includes: a snack in the morning and in the afternoon and lunch. You can change the suggested menu for health reasons (with the doctor's prescription) or for religious reasons.

4. TRANSPORT

It operates from the first day of school both to go and come back from school. It's necessary:

- to fill in the request form;
- to pay a monthly fee.

5. ABSENCES

If the pupil is absent for more than six days, when he comes back to school he must show the doctor's certificate. Without it the pupil isn't accepted at school.

6. CALENDAR

It starts at half September and ends on 30 June. The activities are interrupted:

- 15 days between December and January for Christmas holidays;
- 7 days in March or April for Easter holidays. Other holidays will be communicated directly by the school..

7. DIDACTIC ACTIVITIES

The teachers work with the children to promote their growth through games, sport, exploration of the space, drawings and dialogues.
